Timing the Review. HUD's regulations at 24 CFR 58.22 prohibit grant recipients and their partners from committing or spending HUD or non-HUD funds on any activity that could have an adverse environmental impact or limit the choice of reasonable alternatives prior to completion of an environment review once a project has become "federal."

### **Orientation to Environmental Reviews - HUD Exchange**

The three main types of environmental issues are resource use, population growth, and pollution. Anything in the environment that is used by people is a natural resource. Some natural resources, called renewable resources, are naturally replaced in a relatively short time. Renewable resources include sunlight, wind, and trees.

The EPA performed three types of assessments during review of the CCA to determine compliance with section 194.22: 1.
